Welcome back to school. Your child will have P.E. everyday for 30 minutes. All we ask is that your child come to P.E. prepared, ready to learn, and has a positive attitude. We are starting the school year in a locomotor unit and towards the end of August will move into a throwing and catching unit. During a locomotor unit we work on movements such as: skipping, galloping, sliding, jumping, hopping, and jogging.
