 $\underline{\text{Jan. 8-12}} \sim \text{Model}$ and compare two-digit numbers to determine which is greater or less, mid-chapter check point

 $\underline{\text{Jan. }15\text{-}19}$ \sim Solve problems using the strategy make a model, 10 Less, 10 More, chapter review and test

<u>Jan. 22-26</u> ~ Add and subtract within 20, adding tens, subtracting tens, mid-chapter checkpoint, and using a hundred chart to find sums.

<u>Jan. 29-Feb.2</u> ~ Use models to add ones or tens to a two-digit numbers, make a ten to add a two-digit and one digit numbers, use tens and ones to add two-digit numbers, solve and explain two digit addition word problems by drawing pictures, and adding and subtracting within 100.
