## 2023-2024 REWARDING DESERVING STUDENTS

- <u>Award Assemblies</u> An award assembly will be held for 6<sup>th</sup> grade students and their teachers and another for 7<sup>th</sup> grade students and their teachers on the final day of school. The following awards will be announced and distributed to students during their grade level event. NOTE: Parents are allowed to attend; however, bleacher seating may be the only seating option available. The following categories will be celebrated at the grade level assemblies:
  - o <u>AR</u> 6th and 7th Grade One student at each grade level will receive a certificate and a prize for accumulating the most AR points during the school year.
  - <u>Citizenship</u> 6th and 7th Grade All students who have achieved no detentions, no referrals, and earned a C or above as the final grade in all courses as of 4th quarter midpoint will receive a certificate.
  - o <u>Honor Roll</u> 6th and 7th Grade All students who have made A and A/B Honor Roll for all 3 quarters & through 3:00 p.m. on Friday, May 3 of quarter 4 will receive a certificate.
  - o <u>Perfect Attendance</u> 6th and 7th Grade All students who qualify with no absences, no tardies, and no early checkouts will receive a certificate.
- > <u>Buffalo Fitness Award</u> 6th, 7th, and 8th Grade All students who qualify will be announced and receive a certificate during the PE class by their PE Teacher.
- ➤ Honor Roll Rewards 6th, 7th, and 8th Grade Students earning all A's in a quarter will be eligible for two (2) homework passes to be utilized in the next quarter. Students earning all A's and B's will be eligible for one (1) homework pass to be utilized in the next quarter. This reward will be available for quarters 1, 2, and 3 and must have the approval of the teacher of the course(s) in which the student chooses to implement their earned pass(es). Homework passes expire as noted on the passes and are non-replaceable if lost.
- ➤ <u>Promotion Assembly</u> 8th Grade An award assembly for students earning promotion to 9<sup>th</sup> grade will be held during the school day on the last day of school. NOTE: Parents are allowed to attend; however, bleacher seating may be the only seating option available. The following categories will be celebrated at these ceremonies:
  - o AR One student will receive a certificate and prize for accumulating the most AR points during the school year.
  - o <u>Citizenship</u> All students who have achieved no detentions, no referrals, and earned a C or above as the final grade in all courses as of 4th quarter midpoint will receive a certificate.
  - o <u>Honor Roll</u> *President's Academic Excellence Award* to students who earned all A's for all 3 quarters & through 3:00 p.m. on Friday, May 1 for the 4th quarter. *President's Academic Achievement Award* to students who earned all A's and B's for all 3 quarters & through 3:00 p.m. on Friday, May 3 of quarter 4.
  - o <u>Perfect Attendance</u> All students who qualify with no absences, no tardies, and no early checkouts will receive a certificate.
  - o <u>Villages Athlete Award</u> One female and one male student will receive a certificate.
  - Promotion Certificate All students with passing grades in all core classes will receive a certificate.
